

First Regional Conference on Knowledge Management for Change (KM4Change)

Dates: June 13 - 15, 2023

Venue: Lomé, Togo



PROGRAMME



A. PURPOSE OF THE CONTINENTAL CONFERENCE

The overall objective of the Conference is to climax the 2023 maiden edition of the KM4Change programme as another step in strengthening Knowledge Management in Caritas and improved production and productivity in the developing sector as a whole.

Participants will present their results, receive certificates as "Certified Knowledge Managers", be inducted into the Africa KM4Change Community of Practice and network with the wider global KM Community.

B. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The specific objectives of this assignment are to:

- 1. Afford participants in the 2023 KM4Change Challenge the opportunity to showcase the products/outputs from the challenge and others, and to the disseminate via Caritas Africa's Knowledge Hub knowledge to the public.
- 2. Present, validate, and launch the jointly developed Knowledge Management Strategy Caritas Africa.
- 3. Profile and award successful participants from the Challenge with certificates as Certified Knowledge Managers.
- 4. Outdoor initial steps in implementing the KM Strategy of Caritas Africa and in the National Caritas organisations.
- 5. Present the charter and activities of the KM4Change Community of Practice and invite additional participants to join.
- 6. Generate commitments and support of senior managers, donors, staff, and other relevant stakeholders to foster Knowledge Management as a development strategy.

C. EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- 1. National KM Concepts or recommendations developed by KM4Change participants presented and validated.
- 2. Participants at the KM4Change Challenge recognized and awarded with relevant certificates.
- 3. The Caritas Africa KM Strategy presented and validated.
- 4. The first batch of KM4Change Community of Practice in Africa inaugurated.
- 5. A joint communique prepared and validated for dissemination among relevant actors to seek international support for advancing KM for sustainable development.

D. APPROACH

- a. The Conference shall be hybrid in nature. About thirty (30) participants shall join physically at the <u>Centre d'Accueil Marie & Marthe (C.A.2M) de l'OCDI Caritas</u> in Lomé. The Conference shall be for 3 days from June 13 to 15, 2023 and will start at 9:00am GMT each day and close at 17:00 GMT.
- b. The Conference shall have four (4) key sessions including;

1) Section one: Opening

- a. Opening remarks by leaders in Caritas Africa
- b. Keynote statements from thought leaders on development work and Knowledge Management



2) Section two: Technical discussion

- a. Presentations by the KM4Change participants of their draft KM concepts and knowledge products developed through the trainings
- b. Discussions by Conference participants on the KM concepts and knowledge products presented

3) Section Three: Communique Validation Process

- a. Validation processes of the countries' KM concepts and knowledge products
- b. Presentation and adoption of a joint communique

4) Section Four: Awards Ceremony

- a. Presentation of Certificates of Completion and special awards
- b. Caritas Africa will facilitate wide publicity for the Conference using its convening powers.
- c. Report of the Conference proceedings will be produced and disseminated widely.
- d. The countries' KM concepts and knowledge products will be packaged after the Conference for further engagements.
- e. The contents shall be produced as supporting documents to the joint communique and published widely by Caritas Africa.
- f. This Conference shall be the maiden edition of the Annual KM4Change Conference.
